Dr. Emanuele Lo Menzo graduated from the University of Catania, Italy. After starting a PhD in Clinical Microbiology at the same university, he completed it at Thomas Jefferson University. He subsequently completed the General surgery training at Thomas Jefferson University and the affiliated Lankenau Hospital. After the general surgery training, Dr. Lo Menzo completed a Fellowship in Minimally invasive, bariatric surgery and surgical endoscopy at the Cleveland Clinic in Florida.

Dr. Lo Menzo began his academic career as an Assistant Professor of Surgery at the University of Miami, and as the Chief of Surgery of the Veterans Administration Hospital. After transferring to the University of Maryland he was promoted to Associate Professor of Surgery.

Finally he returned to the Cleveland Clinic Florida as an Associate Professor, he became the Director of the Research Department of the same Institution. Additional administrative responsibilities he fulfilled include the position of Associate Program Director of the general surgery residency program and the directorship of the surgical clerkship for the medical students.

The clinical activity is mainly based on open and laparoscopic operations in bariatric surgery, surgical endoscopy, esophago-gastro-intestinal surgery, biliary surgery, defect of the abdominal wall, and diaphragm, gastroesophageal reflux and disorders of the esophageal motility.

Dr. Lo Menzo is author or co-author of 65 original manuscripts, 11 book chapters, and over 140 Abstracts and presentations at National and International meetings.
