Regular missions in Europe and Third countries have equally provided me with extensive exposure to working in an international context and facilitated the development of a network of international contacts. In addition, leading the Research Support Department in a top-ranking Italian university has given me the opportunity to exploit my natural aptitude as a team motivator and communicator.
